Through this line of action, the Foundation consolidates its role as an agent of social transformation, promoting initiatives that generate value and leave a lasting mark

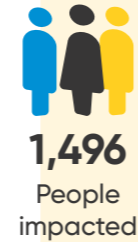
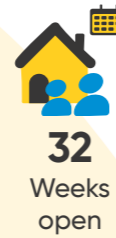
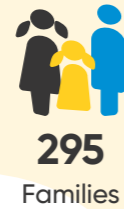

The 2025 financial year reflects a negative result that responds to a deliberate strategic decision: this has been a year of intensive investment, both in the growth and consolidation of the PortAventura Dreams Village programme and in strengthening the Foundation's team –essential pillars for sustaining and expanding the impact of our mission.

This result is fully absorbed by the reserves accumulated by the Foundation in previous financial years, the fruit of responsible and sustained management over time. The strength of the Foundation's own assets guarantees the full operational continuity of the organisation and its capacity to continue generating social impact in the years to come.

# PORTAVENTURA DREAMS VILLAGE

PortAventura Dreams Village is a pioneering social initiative in Europe, aimed at children and young people between the ages of 4 and 17 who suffer or have suffered from serious illnesses included on the Ministry of Health's list.

Family participation is determined through a committee made up of health and social professionals, in collaboration with leading paediatric hospitals such as Hospital Sant Joan de Déu Barcelona, Hospital Infantil Universitario Niño Jesús and Hospital Universitari Vall d'Hebron. Stays are organised by grouping families with similar circumstances, fostering mutual support, reducing isolation and strengthening coping capacity.

Each year, the programme welcomes more than 290 families from across Spain, offering them an environment designed to disconnect from the medical routine, promote psychological wellbeing and create moments of shared quality time. The model places both the child and their family at the centre, creating a space that contributes to their emotional recovery after particularly complex periods.

In 2025, the project advanced by incorporating collaborations with hospitals closer to home, such as Hospital Universitari Joan XXIII de Tarragona and Hospital Universitari Sant Joan de Reus. This initiative enabled paediatric patients undergoing active treatment to access these stays alongside their families, integrating emotional wellbeing as a complement to medical care.

This approach reinforces the importance of family cohesion during illness processes, contributing to improved emotional wellbeing for children and their families, and consolidating a more comprehensive and person-centred model of care.

## THE FIRST CLINICAL STUDY TO DEMONSTRATE THAT THERAPEUTIC LEISURE REDUCES ANXIETY IN FAMILIES WITH SERIOUSLY ILL CHILDREN

Hospital Universitari Vall d'Hebron, in collaboration with Hospital Infantil Universitario Niño Jesús and Hospital Sant Joan de Déu Barcelona, has concluded a pioneering psychological study evaluating the impact of a recreational-therapeutic experience carried out outside the hospital environment on the emotional wellbeing of children with serious illnesses and their families, particularly during advanced stages of treatment.

The work was developed under rigorous methodological criteria, with complete data collection and analysis and an exhaustive scientific evaluation of the results. The academic article has already been written and is pending publication in a specialist scientific journal, with publication planned for 2026, at which point the findings will be shared.

**«We are very pleased with the results of the DREAMS project, which evaluated the impact of a six-day recreational intervention at PortAventura Dreams on caregiver burden, anxiety and paediatric quality of life in 105 paediatric patients and their caregivers referred from Hospital Universitari Vall d'Hebron (Barcelona), Hospital Sant Joan de Déu (Barcelona) and Hospital Infantil Universitario Niño Jesús (Madrid). The study showed that a family recreational intervention, even without professional support, can reduce emotional burden and anxiety in families with children with serious chronic illnesses or ASD (Autism Spectrum Disorder), although the impact on paediatric quality of life requires further investigation.»**

The conclusions point to the value of leisure as a complement to emotional recovery, providing evidence of its positive impact in complex clinical contexts. In parallel, families who have participated in the PortAventura Dreams Village project report clear improvements in children's wellbeing, highlighting greater emotional balance, improved mood, greater calm and a better capacity to face day-to-day life. These perceptions coincide with what the patients themselves express, describing the experience as a positive turning point in their journey.

From the healthcare sphere, the project is valued as a solid, necessary initiative with great human value, which complements medical care with an approach focused on emotional experience.

## A DREAM WEEK

The Dreams Village activity programme is a key element of the experience, designed to create an environment of wellbeing, connection and mutual support among families who share similar situations.

As Paola Grommes, Director of PortAventura Foundation, explains, «Dreams Village is the essence of who we are as PortAventura Foundation: a unique place in southern Europe where families of children with serious illnesses can pause, breathe and reconnect. Here, we offer more than just a stay –we create moments that strengthen bonds, build resilience and leave a lasting positive impact.»

Throughout the week, activities are organised such as welcome workshops, group tours, karaoke, face painting, crafts and creative dynamics such as «magic stones» and «diamond party», as well as relaxation sessions, storytelling and much more. All of these culminate in a group closing session that reinforces the bonds created and promotes mutual support.

In addition, both activities and spaces are adapted to the specific needs of each group, taking into account the diversity of conditions among the participating children, which range from oncological and rare diseases to mental health disorders, neurological and immunological issues, among others. This adaptation ensures an accessible, safe and inclusive experience in which families can disconnect from illness, share experiences and strengthen their resilience in a welcoming and supported environment.

## INCLUSION AND SOLIDARITY THROUGH SPORT

PortAventura Foundation promotes sport as a means of fostering social inclusion and mobilising solidarity, making it an active tool to support groups in vulnerable situations.

Through events and solidarity activities, the Foundation channels the participation of the community and its partners to raise funds for various social organisations. These initiatives combine physical activity, commitment and awareness, generating a direct impact on projects that work for the wellbeing of those who need it most.

### LALIGA GENUINE MOEVE: PROMOTING INCLUSION THROUGH FOOTBALL

In November 2025, the Foundation held a new edition of LALIGA GENUINE MOEVE at PortAventura Park. The event brought together more than 600 players with intellectual disabilities, belonging to 40 teams, in a day centred on the creation of a collective mural.

The activity focused on inclusion, teamwork and coexistence, using sport and leisure as a vehicle for integration. The initiative also raised 3,485 €, donated to solidarity causes.

### SOLIDARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT: SPORT AND COMMITMENT

In November, PortAventura Foundation held the 10th edition of its solidarity golf tournament, raising 10,470 € with the participation of 124 people. The event took place at Infinitem Golf and combined sport and social commitment in a single day.

In addition to the competition, the event included inclusive activities such as a golf introduction session for vulnerable groups linked to the beneficiary organisations, encouraging participation and shared experience.


The funds raised were allocated to social projects of Jeroni de Moragas, Associació Contra el Càncer a Tarragona and the Foundation's own Dreams Village initiative, reinforcing the local impact of the solidarity action.




### FUN RUN: A SOLIDARITY RACE WITH SOCIAL IMPACT

The 13th edition of the Fun Run brought together more than 1,500 participants in a sporting and family day held in the grounds of the park. Runners could choose between routes of 5 and 10 kilometres, while the youngest participants took part in children's races in a fun and participatory atmosphere.

The amount raised reached 22,470 €, which was allocated to two associations selected through the Foundation's first call for grants: Fundación Soñar Despierto and Fundació Diagrama, as well as Dreams Village itself. This edition consolidated the Fun Run as a key event in the Foundation's solidarity activities.

## CHRISTMAS ACTIONS IN PAEDIATRIC HOSPITALS

During Christmas 2025, PortAventura Foundation carried out various activities in leading paediatric hospitals, with the aim of humanising the hospital environment and contributing to the emotional wellbeing of children and their families. These initiatives reinforce the Foundation's social commitment and highlight the impact of small gestures in particularly sensitive contexts.



### HOSPITAL UNIVERSITARI SANT JOAN DE REUS

At Hospital Universitari Sant Joan de Reus, the Foundation shared a Christmas day with paediatric patients, accompanied by iconic PortAventura World characters and the volunteer team. The visit transformed the hospital routine into a warmer and more joyful environment, creating moments of excitement for the children and their families.

The aim of the activity was to bring normality, companionship and emotional wellbeing during the hospital stay, reinforcing the role of affective support in the care process. Both families and healthcare professionals highlighted the value of this type of initiative in improving day-to-day life in hospital.

### HOSPITAL JOAN XXIII DE TARRAGONA

At Hospital Universitari Joan XXIII de Tarragona, the action focused on the maternal and child area. The characters Woody and Winnie, together with the volunteer team, visited different units including Paediatrics, Maternity, Paediatric ICU, Neonatal ICU and A&E, creating moments of warmth and positive distraction for patients and families.

During the day, gifts were distributed to the children, creating a meaningful experience in a highly sensitive environment. The activity was developed in coordination with the hospital management and the Paediatrics Department, consolidating the ongoing collaboration between both organisations.

### CHRISTMAS LIGHTS CEREMONY AT HOSPITAL SANT JOAN DE DÉU

On 9 December, the Foundation collaborated in the traditional Encesa de Llums (Christmas Lights Ceremony) at Hospital Sant Joan de Déu Barcelona, facilitating the transfer of a team of volunteers to take part in the celebration.

In addition, PortAventura World offered its «It's Christmas» show at SésamoAventura for patients, families and professionals at the hospital, helping to create a festive and uplifting atmosphere within the hospital environment.

## ACCESSIBILITY TO LEISURE: INCLUSION THROUGH SHARED EXPERIENCE

In 2025, PortAventura Foundation continued to drive initiatives aimed at facilitating access to leisure for children and young people in vulnerable situations. Through the provision of free or reduced-price tickets to PortAventura Park, the Foundation has collaborated with local social organisations working with children with serious illnesses or at risk of social exclusion.

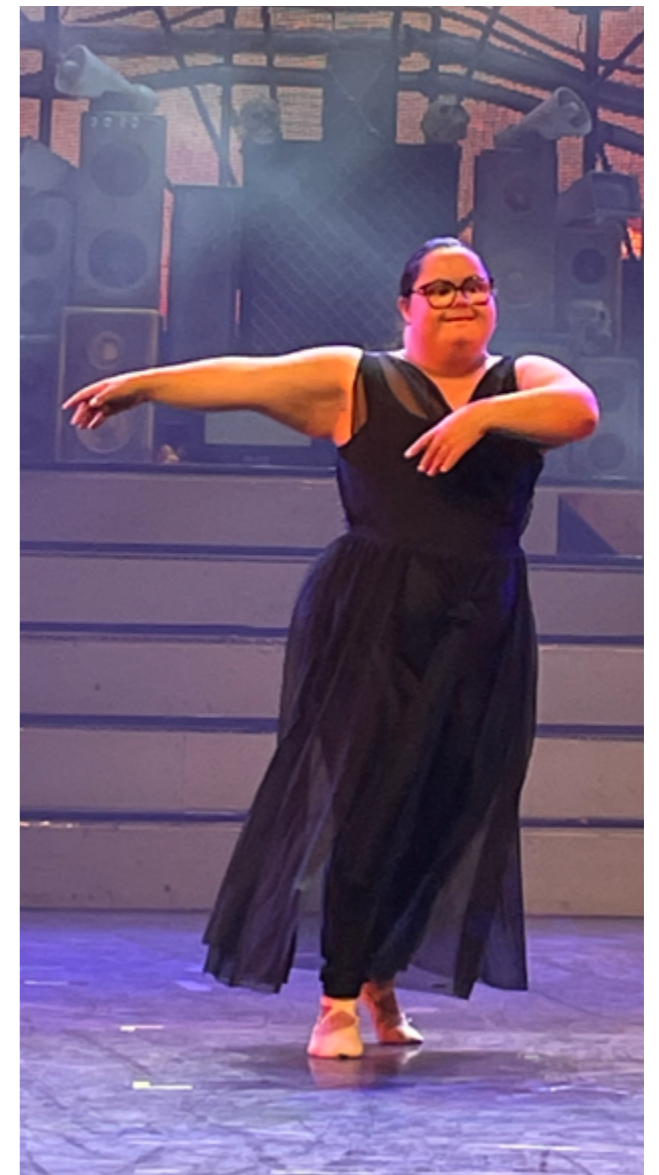
### 277 UKRAINIAN SMILES

As part of the leisure access initiatives, the Foundation participated in coordinating a visit by 277 Ukrainian children, as part of a project driven by Sor María Lucía Caram Padilla and Fundació del Convent de Santa Clara. The day, held at PortAventura World, offered the children a safe environment for socialising, play and relaxation, with the aim of recovering spaces of joy and emotional wellbeing.

### FENT AMICS WITH DOWN CATALUNYA

Once again, the Fent Amics day, organised together with Down Catalunya, brought together thousands of participants in an inclusive leisure experience at PortAventura World. The event combined fun, awareness and coexistence, reinforcing the construction of a more inclusive society.

Thanks to the sale of solidarity tickets, the funds raised will be allocated to inclusive leisure programmes driven by Down Catalunya and its federated organisations, contributing to improving the quality of life, autonomy and social participation of people with Down syndrome and intellectual disabilities.

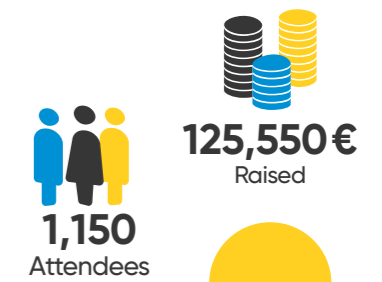
## THE SOLIDARITY DINNER: A NIGHT OF SHARED COMMITMENT AND SOLIDARITY

PortAventura Foundation held the 14th edition of its Solidarity Dinner in 2025, an event now established as one of the region's leading fundraising and social commitment occasions. The gathering brought together 1,150 attendees at the PortAventura World Convention Centre, reaching a total fundraising figure of 125,550 €, allocated to projects with social impact.

Under the motto «A night that embraces many lives», the evening combined musical performances, entertainment, raffles and auctions, creating an atmosphere of shared participation and emotion. A team of 60 volunteers, made up of resort workers, actively collaborated in the organisation and development of the event to maximise fundraising.

The funds raised were distributed among Fundació La Muntanyeta, Fundació Enriqueta Villavecchia and the Dreams Village initiative itself, reinforcing support for projects focused on accompaniment and wellbeing of people in vulnerable situations. This year's edition also featured an especially moving element, with a tribute to Ramon Marsal –the Foundation's president since its inception– who announced his departure after a long career of dedication. During the event, his work and contribution to the Foundation's growth were recognised, with particular emphasis on the impact of Dreams Village.

A night that once again demonstrated the power of collaboration and solidarity as a driver of social transformation.

The PortAventura World Teaming initiative reflects the joint commitment of the company and its workforce to various social causes, channelling voluntary monthly contributions that generate a direct impact on the community.

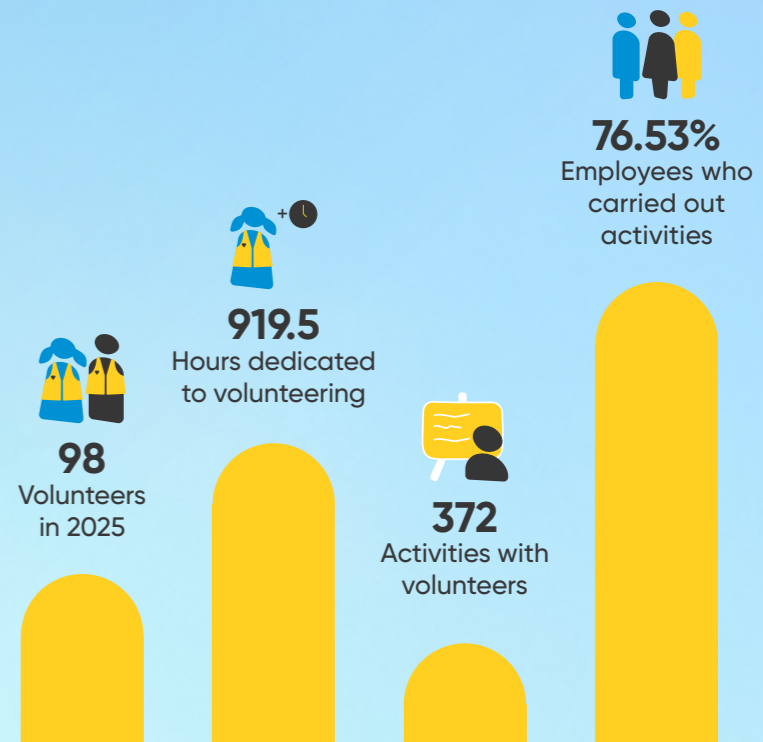


**PLASTIC CAP

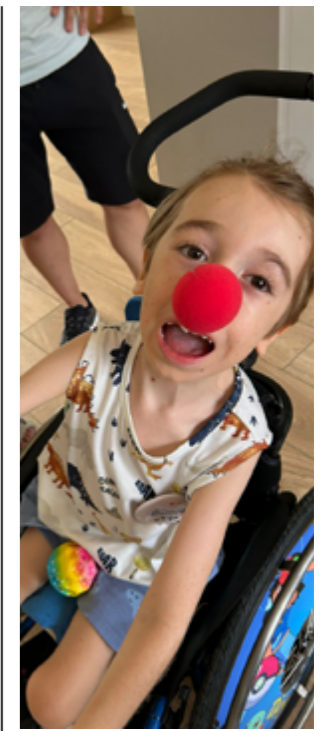
